Mediterranean Area Fuels

Starting May 1, 2025, the Mediterranean Sea will be designated as an Emission Control Area (ECA) for sulfur oxides (SOx). This designation mandates that all vessels operating in the Mediterranean must use marine fuels with a sulfur content not exceeding 0.10%, a significant reduction from the current limit of 0.50%. Alternatively, ships can employ exhaust gas cleaning systems (EGCS) to achieve equivalent SOx emission reductions. This initiative aims to substantially decrease air pollution in the region, benefiting both human health and the environment. Ship operators should prepare by ensuring the availability of compliant low-sulfur fuels and implementing appropriate fuel changeover procedures before entering the Mediterranean Sea. It's also important to note that similar SOx ECAs exist in the Baltic Sea, the North Sea, the North American area, and the United States Caribbean Sea area.

LL: once more checks are important.




LEARNING FROM A NEAR MISS

LL: report any buzzing to your supervisor.












LEARNING FROM A NEAR MISS

Save our planet follow the Company's recommendations on garbage segregation .






